Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre:

- Australia's most awarded convention centre
- Officially ranked among the top three convention centres world-wide by the Association Internationale des Palais de Congres (AIPC) on three separate occasions
- Following the completion of Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre on Grey Street, Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre will be Australia's most flexible meetings and events venue with three stand alone tiered plenary halls able to accommodate from 400 to 8,000
- The new expanded Centre will have a total of 41 meeting rooms and event spaces and three dedicated Speakers' Presentation Centres
- The Centre is located in the unique city riverside precinct at South Bank, home to Brisbane's thriving arts and cultural community
- The Centre has established a permanent art gallery space to house its collection of Indigenous and contemporary Australian art
- There are 27 hotels within two kilometres of the Centre including two directly adjacent to the Centre
- The Centre which has all its facilities under the one roof offers a wide range of in house services including its award winning catering and Audio Visual Production Services Team providing on site expert technical support for every event
- Winner of the IMEX 2010 Green Supplier Silver Award for environmental excellence
- Winner of 47 restaurant and catering awards, the Centre has been named Australia's Best Function/Convention Centre Caterer by Restaurant & Catering Australia
- The Centre caters for more than one million meals per year and consumes more than 20,000 tonnes of farm fresh greens each year
