



BEING GREEN AT BCEC



The Centre is proud to participate in **AEG 1 EARTH**. This program tracks our environmental performance on energy and water consumption and contributes to its 2020 Environmental Goals

Our **organic waste dehydrator** turns 100kg of organic waste into 10kg of **SoilFood™** a nutrient rich and safe to handle soil enhancer. **We donate this to the City Parkland Services** to use on the South Bank and Roma Street Parklands



BCEC has **EarthCheck Gold accreditation**. The global certification program acknowledges the Centre's compliance to the highest environmental standards

Recycled water is used to **clean the facility's roof**, approx. 37,500m². The process of **redirecting water to collection containers recycles 170,000L for reuse** and preventing pollution to the water system through storm water drains



BCEC has a **strategic partnership with Tangalooma EcoMarines (TEM)** to protect the marine environment and wildlife within Moreton Bay

The Centre's **escalators are sensor driven**, resulting in a 30% reduction in escalator energy usage



Partners with Foodbank, Australia's largest hunger relief organisation donating pre packaged meals on a regular basis

In 2017, BCEC **reduced its energy consumption** by 762,192 mega joules which is equivalent to 32 typical 4 person households



FluoroCycle

The Centre is an **official QLD FluoroCycle Signatory**. FluoroCycle is part of the National Waste Policy which seeks to increase the national recycling rate of waste mercury-containing lamps

In the last 10 years BCEC has **reduced its contribution to landfill by 42%**. BCEC recycles a number of items including; batteries, containers, e-waste, glass, grease trap waste, metal, paper and cardboard, plastic and timber
