Policy

BCEC's commitment to sustainability encompasses Environmental, Social and Economic impacts.

BCEC has implemented environmental management systems, processes and organisational structures to meet EarthCheck's Company Standard.

Rationale

Profile

BCEC is a world leading provider of convention and exhibition products and services. BCEC is a purpose-built convention, exhibition and special events facility with a fully integrated range of in-house services hosting an average of over 1100 events each year. The Centre houses 44 meeting and event spaces, four exhibition halls, restaurant facilities and multiple food and beverage outlets.

Risk Impacts

With 1100 events and an average of 800,000 people passing through the Centre on an annual basis, BCEC is a major enterprise and its operation results in the consumption of significant quantities of energy and resources. BCEC develops and promotes processes to ensure the Centre's business and community values encompass economic, environmental and social responsibility and is committed to continually improving its performance and annual benchmarking - a core business principle.

Operating Guidelines

- BCEC is committed to work practices with sustainable values and environmental and community focused outcomes meeting the requirements of the EarthCheck Company Standard.
- BCEC has appointed an EarthCheck Coordinator.
- The Corporate Responsibility Team (CRT) is committed to sustainability by identifying related risks and implementing actions and preventative measures to achieve desired outcomes.
- Consideration is given to employing and empowering local employees, recognising and practising Fair Trade.
- Wherever possible, environmentally sustainable products and services will be sourced locally.
- We encourage staff to present BCEC's commitment to Corporate Responsibility and our EarthCheck Platinum Standard certification to our clients, guests, suppliers and stakeholders.
- Sustainability is a mandatory requirement within the BCEC's orientation program for all staff; this extends to individual department inductions and forms part of the yearly compliance training.
- Sustainability forms part of BCEC's contractor induction program.

This policy has been developed to provide a clear statement of BCEC's commitment to managing both its environmental and social impacts. BCEC will set appropriate objectives to support the Sustainability Policy, these include:

- Commitment to reduce / minimise energy, waste and water consumption.
- Promotion of recycling activities.
- Commitment to achieve a positive social impact on the local and wider communities.
- Promotion of sustainable practices to BCEC clients, suppliers and stakeholders.
- Commitment to comply with legislative and other requirements.
